CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN

The following is the Classroom Management Plan for 2014:

- Follow teacher's instructions;
- Respect other people, no 'put downs';
- Use appropriate language;
- Remain in their seat unless given permission to move;
- Bring all equipment to class; and
- Complete all set work on time.

There is a series of clear, staged consequences for students who do not follow these expectations.
